



## HPCL Indoor Skating Rules

**In addition to the rules set by Kinsmen Twin Areas, during the Heritage Point Community League reserved rink time, members are to abide by the following rules:**

- Proof of valid Heritage Point Community League membership is required to use the rink.
- Skate tags are to be worn at all times. If you need skate tags – please contact [membership@heritagepointcl.ca](mailto:membership@heritagepointcl.ca) to get yours by mail.
- There is zero tolerance for abuse of any type toward community league volunteers on site checking for membership cards or skate tags. Any member(s) displaying this type of behaviour will be asked to leave the premises and may have skating privileges revoked.
- Children under 6 yrs of age must be supervised by someone 13 yrs of age or older.
- Helmets are strongly recommended for all ages.
- Skate at your own risk.
- In the event rink capacity, as determined by the City of Edmonton/Kinsmen arenas is met, skaters will limit their enjoyment of the ice to 30 minutes to allow other members a chance to skate.
