

Canada Day Hat

Supplies

1-2 sheets of paper (or thin cardboard/cardstock)

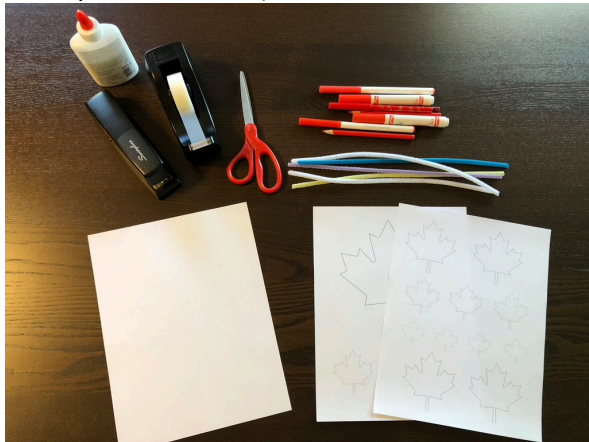
Stapler or tape or glue

Scissors

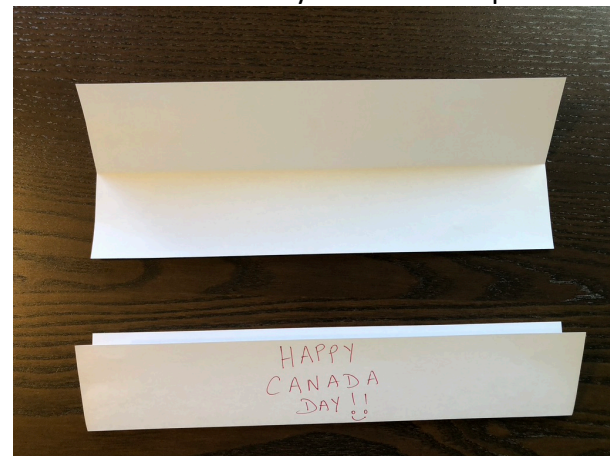
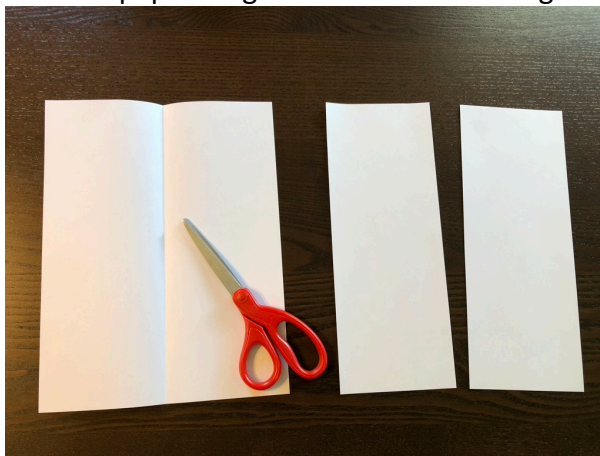
Maple leaf template (see website)

Markers or crayons (for colouring)

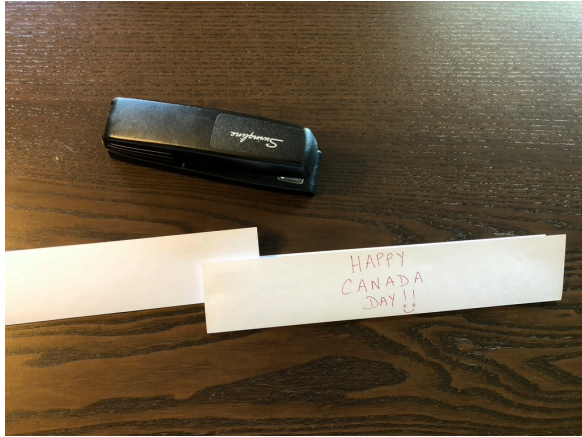
A couple pipe cleaners (if you don't have pipe cleaners, try popsicle sticks, straws or toothpicks/skewers)



Take one sheet of paper, fold it lengthwise and cut along the fold to make two long length. Alternatively, you can cut out two long stripes from thin cardstock/cardboard if you have some. Fold the paper lengthwise and add a design to the crown of the hat if you like at this point.



Join the two pieces together using a stapler or some tape. Connect the two ends to make a band big enough to fit the person wearing it. Use a third piece of paper if needed to get around the person's head.



Cut out and colour maple leaves using the template (as many as you like). Attach each leaf to a short piece of pipe cleaner (5-10 cm) or some sort of stick using glue, stapler or tape. You can sandwich the pipe cleaner between two maple leaves of the same size using glue. Attach the pipe cleaner with the maple leaf all around the hat using a stapler or tape. You can tuck the stick in-between the fold.
